ENTRY RULES FOR THE TASC TOP VIDEO COMPETITION

1. Video entries must be submitted via the TASC website and completed in its entirety.
2. Video content must be student council events/activities in relation to the TASC state theme.
3. ONE entry per council per year.
4. Video can be made using any editing tools but must be uploaded to YouTube to qualify as a top video.
5. Copyright infringement will not be tolerated(audio or video) Any video that is deemed to violate copyright will be disqualified. Videos that have inappropriate content will be disqualified.
6. Entries must be no less than a 1 minute in length and no longer than 2 ½ minutes in length.
7. Schools must ensure proper releases and permission for students being in the video are held by their school/school district.
8. Video must have been created between the annual conference of the previous year to the entry deadline.
9. Video entries must be **received** by the deadline.
10. Award winning videos may be shown at the Annual Conference.
11. Winning entries will be uploaded as links on the TASC Top Video Page by TASC staff.
12. Winning entries will be recognized at Annual Conference and receive one plaque per video winner.
13. The entry should be a student production. It may include portions of professionally produced videos and TV broadcasts, but the entry should be created by students along with the guidance and support of their advisors.
14. Entries will be evaluated by the judging criteria rubric included below. (content, quality of production, technical skill, and final product)



CONTENT 50%

Script: How closely the submission covers the specified components and guidelines.

Retention: Does the submissions's topic spark the audience's interest and motivate.

Creativity: The overall originality of the submission; use of original ideas, illustrations, and style.

Pertinence: The objective is for the submission to pertain to TASC state theme.

QUALITY OF PRODUCTION 30%

Visual Aesthetics: the overall appearance of the submission

Cinematography: the quality and appropriateness of audio and lighting

Adherence to the time limit

TECHNICAL SKILL 20%

Camera operation: camera angles, steadiness, etc.

Editing: video transitions, stitching of videos, etc.
