Hi, my name is Nicole.

Did you know the <u>#1 cause</u> of teenager deaths is car accidents?

~5,000 Teens are <u>Killed</u> in Car Accidents Every Year

~500,000 Teens are <u>Injured</u> in Car Accidents Every Year



The causes vary, but can be categorized as:

1) Driver Inexperience 2) Driving with Teenage Passengers **3) Driver Distraction** 4) Reckless Driving **5) Impaired Driving** 6) Night Time Driving 7) Driving while Drowsy



55% of the teenagers were <u>not wearing a</u> <u>seatbelt</u> at the time of death

Sadly, most of these deaths are preventable





I became a statistic at the age of 16 when I was killed in this car.

I was a passenger in a car being driven by my girlfriend, also 16. Four other cars, with 2 classmates each, were driving to our friend's 16th birthday celebration hosted by his parents.

For what ever reason, along the way my girlfriend decided she wanted to be the lead car, so she started to drive very fast trying to pass the other cars.

She lost control of the car and slammed head on into this pole at a speed of 101mph! My girlfriend survived with minor injury. I was killed instantly. I know what you're thinking, they were drinking or texting... No, we weren't. Reckless behavior and inexperienced driving skills of the driver, my girlfriend, resulted in my loss of life.



One of the other drivers that day was my friend and classmate, Lance.

Lance witnessed the horrific car crash happen.

He wrote this letter to my family telling them how we became friends and how we would hang out etc.

He wrote how cute he thought it was that I used to nickname some of my friends with a "y" at the end of their name. I called him "Lancey" (hehe).

Lance wrote that he thought he should give "me" a nickname, so he said he's going to start calling me "Nickel" since my initials were NKL (haha!!!)

He pencil shaded a Nickel on the top of the letter...

I saw your daughter for the first I was scared to afleast even say hi beauty was only one of her make was a great friend. ities she to hang out with her better. However Know Archother hang with the aroup an L'always telt the time. y for being the third -I hung out with the two of them Nicole aways made sure I knew she wanted me to be there with them. Nicole was a social butterfly! Everytime we saw each other in the hall she would light up. Even if it was just hello, it made my day everytim on the end Like maxy of Lancey ut everyone's name. a special thing to have frienship Nicole, Oh and if vou're wondering why her a funny nickname since sho led me Lancey all the time. a nickel on my car radio to always Her death will save many to drive Safely. others. Even though I don't know you guys LOVE YOU LEGROW FA L will Kept Hunter strong!

Lance also taped a "Nickel" to the dashboard of his car to always remember me, and to remind himself to drive safely. After seeing me die, he thought my story could save other lives.



My family started a nonprofit in my memory called "Nickel from Nicole"

Teen Killed in Car Crash

A 16-year-old passenger was killed and driver transported to an area hospital following a single car crash on HWY 121 Thursday. The car was traveling at an unsafe speed when the driver lost control of the vehicle and collided with a guide sign in the center median...

Nicole, "Nickel" to some of her friends, was a passenger in this car and she died July 8th. She was a responsible 16 year old who played soccer, volleyball, volunteered, worked, had a boyfriend, went to homecoming and chilled with her family and friends. She was just like you. She accepted a ride from a friend one day and now many lives are changed forever.
