


We understand, if elected, both advisor and student representative are expected to attend the TASC State Steering Committee Meeting.



We understand, if elected, both advisor and student representative are expected to attend the TASC Summer Board Meeting.




We understand, if elected, both advisor and student representative are expected to attend the TASC Fall Board Meeting.



We understand, if elected, both advisor and student representative are expected to attend the TASC Annual Conference.




We understand, if elected, both advisor and student representative will be responsible for some expenses related to optional travel (i.e. travel to Out of State Conference).
