People to Thank: People who helped set up the program, people who also donated dresses, and the news reporters that helped get our message out. The theatre program that lended their dressing rooms.

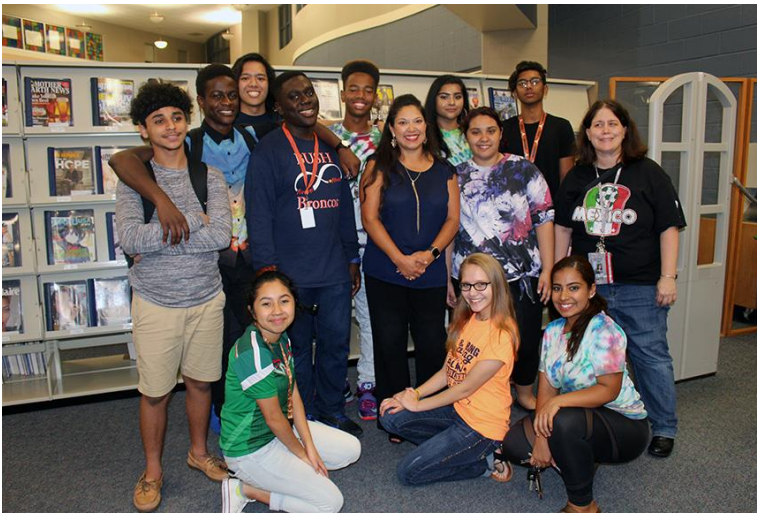
