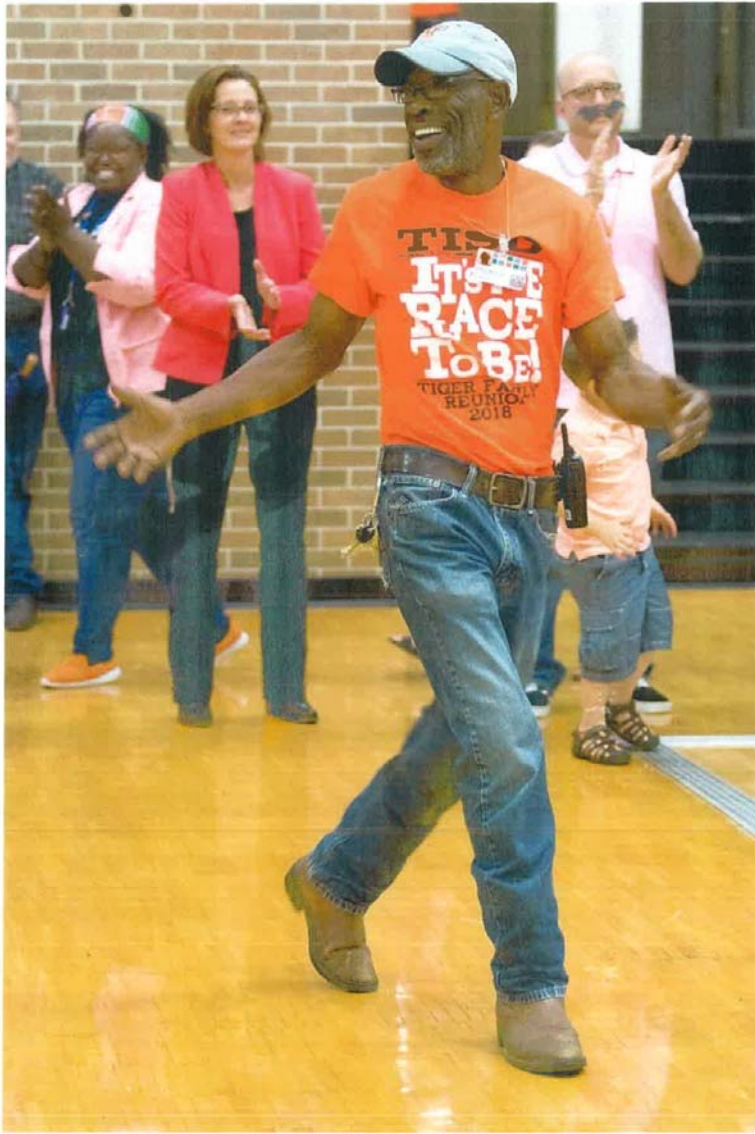

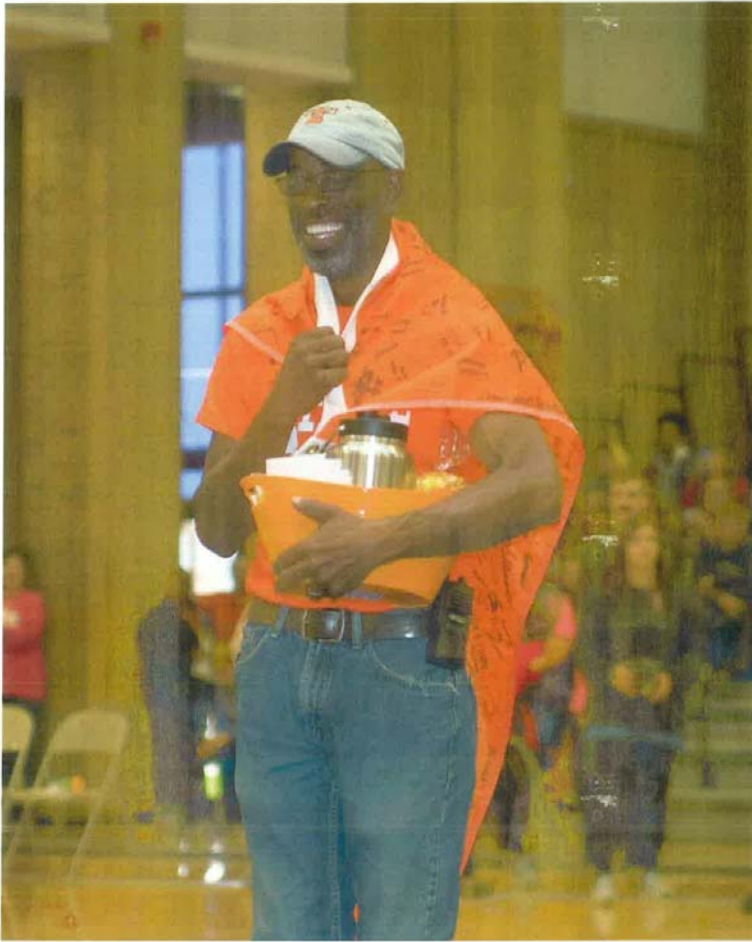

Name: Thanks Bobby- Dude Be Nice!

Purpose and Objectives: The aim of this project was to unite the Texas High student body and faculty and to recognize and show our appreciation for a custodian.

Description of Activities: Texas High Student Council coordinated a pep rally with a surprise for Bobby, a custodian. Bobby was called to the middle of the gym floor and students and faculty started chanting his name; a cape was put around his neck; students held up thank you signs and posters with his face on them, and he was presented a Thank You gift bag with notes from individual students and gift cards. Student leaders held a banner with student signatures.

Description of Involvement:
